



Golf Course Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations must be complied with by all members and their guests in order for everyone to enjoy and play a safe game

- 1) Members must sign in with the clubhouse manager or assistant when the clubhouse is open and outside when it is closed.
- 2) Members are responsible for getting their respective guests signed in, either in person or with a written notice, and guest fees paid to the clubhouse manager/assistant or placed in the money box outside when the clubhouse is closed. Guest fees are \$20 for all day, except Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day weekends when the fee is \$30 for all day. Unaccompanied Guests pay \$40.00 for all day. *Guest fees for Chip & Putt, Scotch ball, League play is \$10 - if only playing nine holes.*
- 3) Motorized golf carts must have a club cart pass affixed to the right side of the windshield. Fees for cart passes are \$5 per day or \$50 per year.
- 4) For their protection, children under six (6) are not allowed on golf course. Children six (6) to twelve (12) must be accompanied by an adult.
- 5) No one under the age of 16 is allowed to drive a golf cart on the golf course. The number of occupants of a golf cart is limited to two.
- 6) Each player is responsible for any injuries/damages which result from his/her play (golf balls, clubs, cart, etc.)
- 7) Each player must have his/her own set of clubs and bag.
- 8) No more than four (4) players will be allowed in any group (without permission from the clubhouse).
- 9) Any player not signed in will be asked to return to the clubhouse or leave the course.
- 10) Slow players must allow faster players to play through without having to be asked.
- 11) All players will begin on #1 tee unless permission is given by a marshal or clubhouse attendant.
- 12) Make sure that fairways and greens are clear before driving. You must warn other players by yelling "Fore" if they are in danger of being hit by your ball.
- 13) The #6 hole is a dog-leg and must be played as such to prevent bodily harm and property damage in that area.
- 14) Limit the time looking for lost or out of bound balls to three minutes.
- 15) Replace divots. The grass will continue to grow if you put the divot back and firmly tamp down.
- 16) No dogs (including in carts), horses, or bicycles are allowed on the golf course.
- 17) Do not lay golf clubs/bags on greens. All carts and bags must be kept fifteen (15) feet from greens.
- 18) Players finishing the 9th hole will place marked ball in ball tube for their turn.
- 19) On busy days, you must form groups of three (3) or four (4).
- 20) You must place your marked ball in ball tube for your turn.
- 21) Failure to comply with these rules may result in being asked to leave the golf course or suspension of privileges.
